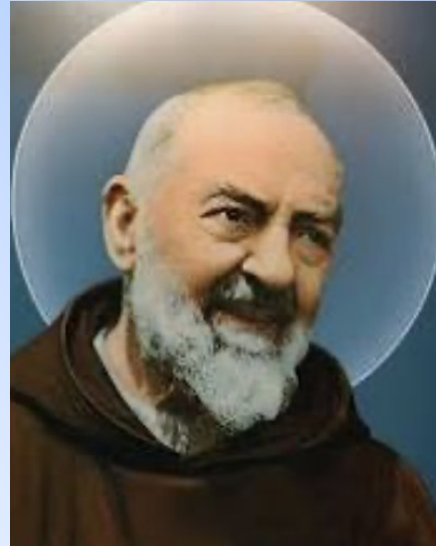

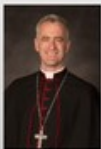

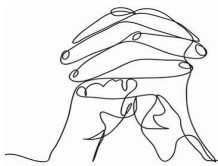

REPORT SEXUAL ABUSE
