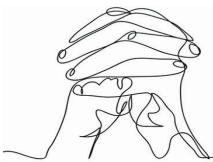

In addition to our regular Tuesday schedule of Eucharistic Adoration following the 9:00 a.m. Mass, we are pleased to begin extended hours of Adoration on the last Tuesday of each month.

Beginning Tuesday, June 30, 2026, the Church of the Holy Family will extend Eucharistic Adoration until 6:30 p.m., followed by Benediction from 6:30 to 7:00 p.m.

On regular Tuesdays, Eucharistic Adoration will begin after the 9:00 a.m. Mass and conclude at 3:00 p.m. with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
