Fr. Loi Duc Tran, CSF, is a religious priest of the Congregation of the Holy Family in the Diocese of Long Xuyen, Vietnam. He earned a Master of Science in Education and completed his philosophical studies in the Philippines before coming to the United States in 2019 to pursue theological studies at Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Connecticut, where he earned a Master of Divinity.

Fr. Loi was ordained to the priesthood on January 25, 2024. He began his priestly ministry as Parochial Vicar at Most Precious Blood Parish in the Diocese of Camden, New Jersey. In August 2024, he was assigned as Parochial Vicar at Saint Monica Parish in Atlantic City.

Beginning in September 2026, Fr. Loi will serve both Saint Monica Parish in Atlantic City and Holy Family Parish in Sewell, continuing his priestly ministry in the Diocese of Camden.

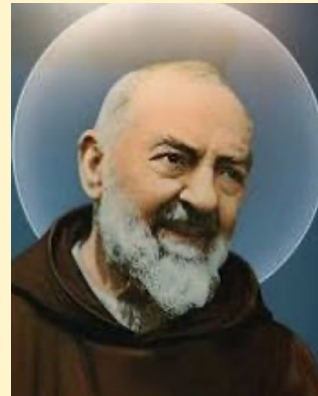

Join Holy Family's Next Bible Study Class

Fulfilled: Uncovering the Biblical Foundations of Catholicism (Part One)

In the Old Testament, God began laying the foundation for the traditions of the Catholic Faith and unfolding the plan fulfilled by Jesus in the New Testament.

Fulfilled: Uncovering the Biblical Foundations of Catholicism (Part One) is a seven-session study that explores how the Old Testament reveals the foundations of the Catholic Faith. Using the Tabernacle as a blueprint for God's plan, this study takes an apologetic approach to explaining the Catholic Faith through Scripture.

This 7-session course, presented by Sonja Corbitt, consists of DVD presentations, small group discussions and home study.

Fulfilled: Uncovering the Biblical Foundations of Catholicism (Part One), a 7-session study, will be offered here at Holy Family in the Aquin Center, on Tuesday evenings, starting on Oct. 13th, at 7:15 PM. This study is scheduled to complete in December, 2026.

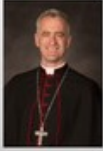

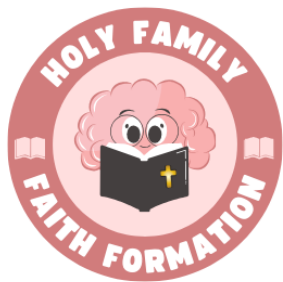
ADORATION SCHEDULE
